an early plantation of Captain Skeete (born in 1612 and raised in Surrey)

Our tour follows his acquisitions in St Philip, in the south-east of Barbados

Foursquare now produces rum— see how it is made and enjoy the folk museum of old Barbadian life

Golden Grove

a fabulous Plantation "Great House" that became independent in 1674 (firstly part of Skeete's 4,500 acre estate at Three Houses founded in 1639)

Discover stories of slave rebellion, view an exhibit on Amerindian Life and listen to the Curator's Tale

Its namesake fled Barbados for his life & his original church was raised to the ground.

Learn how his persecution was used to further the cause of Emancipation

Foul Bay

As the afternoon sun lowers we take you for a beautiful stroll. Imagine a deserted Barbados by the Atlantic shore!

The land around Foul Bay became a pioneer plantation for Captain Skeete— he owned both this land and Foursquare before he bought Three Houses
